HILLIARD, Ohio (June 30, 2025) — The Columbus Food Truck Festival returns Aug. 16–17 to the Franklin County Fairgrounds for its 14th year, bringing with it a full weekend of great eats, live music, unique shopping and a brand-new VIP experience. Recently named the No. 4 Best City Food Festival in the U.S. by USA Today, the event continues to grow as one of the Midwest's premier summer celebrations. This year's festival features more than 40 food trucks, a curated artisan and vintage market, and a lineup of musical performances on the outdoor stage.
